Delph Woods River Trip -Wednesday 24th September

Dear Parents / Carers,

To help the children with their learning about rivers, we have organised a trip to Delph Wood in Poole. Once there, we will aid the children in carrying out a number of practical river investigations. Children will explore the river habitat, measure the flow of the river, take a profile of a meander and calculate water quality by surveying invertebrates. Furthermore, they will take a short walk to observe a natural landscape and how its formation links to the water cycle.
