Welcome to Local Food Links' school lunches! Local Food Links have been making delicious and nutritious school lunches since 2006. All our meals are freshly prepared every day in local kitchens using great quality ingredients that are locally sourced wherever possible. 

We work hard to produce menus and meals that appeal to children and are packed full of healthy goodness. Great for kids and great for parents!

School lunches are **FREE** for all children in Reception, Year 1 and 2 (and some older children whose families receive financial support), Meals are only £2.40 for children in Year 3 and above.

With a choice of 3 main course options every single day, followed by a pudding or piece of fruit, we're sure that your child will quickly find lots of meals they love.

We've made ordering school meals easy!

To order online, register your details at <https://my.localfoodlinks.org.uk/>. You will receive a 10-digit unique activation code from the school for each of your children and you will then be able to order school meals online from Local Food Links.

You are able to order and manage your meals online but be aware that we require 7 days' notice to order, change or cancel any meals.

You will also receive our useful 'Ordering Guide' leaflet which gives clear step by step instructions.

We would strongly encourage you to subscribe to our emails. Each term we send out friendly order reminders delivered straight to your inbox, this is especially useful for the first & second weeks back to school after half terms. Sometimes families are having too much fun & forget to order in time!

Why our lunches are great for your kids!

Research shows that children concentrate better & stay more focused after a hot school meal and that children enjoy the social experience of eating a meal with other children & are often more likely to try new things.

The nutritional benefits of a school meal often far outweigh those of a packed lunch.

All our meals meet the School Food Standards.

Our meat is British and all our eggs are free range.

All our meals are prepared daily using fresh ingredients.

So with one of our school lunches, you'll know your children are well fed and fuelled for an afternoon of learning!



LFL Packed Lunches

Packed lunches are available for School Trips & event days. These can be ordered directly through the school and are free for KS1 (and means tested KS2 children).

Our lunches contain a filled roll or sandwich, bag of crisps, flapjack and a piece of fruit.

When you have a letter home about an upcoming school trip you should also have the option to order a packed lunch, if not ask at the school office!

Food Allergies/Special Dietary Requirements

We want to make sure all children, including those with food allergies or special dietary requirements, can benefit from a hot school meal.

We make it easy for you to check that our meals are suitable for your children by giving full details of ingredients, dish by dish, within the my.localfoodlinks.org.uk/ online ordering system. Simply click on any meal choice to bring up the list of ingredients. We also mark the most common allergens on the paper menus and on a spreadsheet which is available on our website www.localfoodlinks.org.uk under the 'For Parents' section.

For children with medically confirmed food allergies or special dietary requirements we can provide bespoke meals. You will need to complete an Allergy Form (available from the school office or download from LFL website) and provide medical evidence (i.e. a copy of a doctor's letter).
