

EYFS Curriculum Overview - Summer Term 2025

Literacy

Phonics:

In Phonics, we will be reading and writing words containing the digraphs sh, ch, th, ng, wh, ck and q/u. We will use our skills to write words containing spellings we have already learned.

Comprehension:

We will be sharing and discussing a range of texts such as 'Sam Plants a Sunflower', 'The Gruffalo' and 'Dear Zoo'.

Writing:

In Writing, the children will be responding to a variety of texts. We will be retelling stories, adapting familiar stories and writing simple sentences independently, using finger spaces and full stops.

RE:

During RE this term, the children will learn about Noah's Ark and special places for a range of religions.

Mathematics:

In maths, the children will be counting to 20 and beyond. This will include building numbers beyond 10, counting patterns beyond 10, recognising the pattern of the counting system and ordering numbers to 20.

The children will also be looking at adding and subtraction, doubling and sharing.

Within numerical patterns, the children will be learning about spatial reasoning, matching, rotating and manipulating numbers and shapes.

Understanding the world:

In Science, the children will be learning about plants and what they need to help them grow.

In History, the children will be learning about who our King is and why he is important.

In Geography, the children will learn about where they live in relation to the wider world.

Communication and Language:

During this term, we will be looking at developing the children's listening skills. We will be focusing on asking questions and having back and forth conversations. The children will learn to organise and sequence talk.

Ways to help at Home:

Please read with and listen to your child read daily.

Spellings to learn will be sent home weekly.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

This Term we will be looking at 'Being my Best'. This will include bouncing back when things go wrong. We will also be learning about healthy eating, having a healthy mind, moving our body and the importance of a good night's sleep.

Expressive Arts and Design:

The children will be developing their creative skills through music lesson and arts and crafts. In music, the children will be looking at 'The Big Bear Funk' and during art the children will be exploring print, then using these skills to produce a final piece of printed art.

Physical Development:

During this term, the children will not only continue to develop their fine motor skills but also develop their gross motor skills in PE. During PE, the children will be participating in Athletics and Tennis.
