

Year 2 Curriculum Overview - Summer Term 2025

Topic (History, Geography, Art, DT):

History:

In History, the children will learn about the Great Fire of London and identify some similarities with the Great Fire of Blandford.

Geography:

In Geography, the children will be comparing the water village of Kampong Ayer in Borneo with our town of Blandford Forum.

Art:

The children will be creating birds as part of 3D sculpture. They will also be exploring how their birds can stand up.

DT:

The children will explore to make axles and wheels and use their knowledge and understanding to create a vehicle with moving wheels.

RE:

Summer 1: Does going to a Mosque give Muslims a sense of belonging?
Summer 2: Does completing Hajj make a person a better Muslim?

Growing and changing

English:

Reading:

To begin the term, the children will consolidate their reading skills. Later in the term, the children will begin another book as a whole class reader, 'The Nothing to See Here Hotel,' answering comprehension questions to strengthen their inference and understanding skills.

Writing:

In writing, the children will plan and write their own story. They will also write some descriptions, a non-chronological report and a recount about a school trip. They will also write a recount on the Great Fire of London.

Maths:

This term, we will be learning about fractions, finding a half and a quarter of amounts and shapes.

Later, the children will learn how to tell the time to half past, quarter to and past and in 5-minute intervals.

They will also be drawing and interpreting pictograms. Finally, they will describe turns and movement.

The children will also complete times-table challenges, focusing on the 2s, 5s, 10s and 3 times-tables.

Science:

This term we will be looking at Plants. The children will be observing how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants and what plants need to stay healthy.

Music:

This term the children will be completing two Charanga Units - Music that makes you dance and Exploring improvisation
