In our Geography lessons this half term we have been learning about the geography of our local area. We have used GIS (geographic information systems) **Google Earth Pro** and **Google Maps** to identify the human and natural features in the vicinity of the school and have examined how the land around our school is used. We have also looked how the area around our school has changed over time.

We plan to give the children an opportunity to explore our local area and carry out some fieldwork in order to consolidate our learning.

During the morning of Thursday 24th October we plan to take the children for a walk around our local area to observe and photograph some of the features identified in our lessons.

As the weather is very changeable at this time of year, please can you ensure your child has a waterproof coat and sensible closed toed shoes for the walk.

We will ensure the trip is fully risk assessed.
