## Yr 3 - Charmouth Heritage Centre - Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> October

Dear Parents / Carers

Our first Science topic in the Autumn Term focuses on "Rock and soils". The children will be learning about different types of rocks and soils and also how fossils are formed.

In order to support their learning in a practical way, we have organised to go on a 'Wow!' visit to Charmouth Heritage Centre. During the day we will have a talk from the staff about fossils and rock types, look around the centre itself and then be taken on a guided walk on the beach to hunt for fossils!
