PAULTONS PARK - MONDAY 24TH MARCH 2025

Dear Parents/Carers,

This term we have planned a very exciting trip for Year 5 to visit Paultons Park.

This trip will give us opportunities to investigate and experience this term's Science learning about Forces. The visit will include a session in 'Professor Blast's Learning Lab', where children will get the chance to hold real rollercoaster parts as they explore forces and energy types in this interactive workshop. During the rest of the day, children will visit and experience many of the rides and attractions in small groups, experiencing first-hand the forces at work!

Children will be carrying their belongings throughout the day, so it is recommended that they have a comfortable backpack to wear. They will not be required to wear school uniform, but should wear practical clothes appropriate to the weather and comfortable shoes (trainers). Please ensure that they have a waterproof coat in case of rain. We will ensure that all risks are assessed and minimised, and that the trip is well staffed to ensure adequate supervision at all times.

The trip has been supported with a kind donation from the Institute of Mechanical engineers (IMechE), South Region, enabling the cost per pupil to be significantly reduced.
